Thank you for choosing Wilton & Barford Primary School to be your child's first school. We look forward to getting to know you and your child and welcoming you into our community. Please find below details of our induction programme for this year:

### **New Parents' Meeting - Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> June 1700-1800**

You are warmly invited to attend a new parents meeting on the 7<sup>th</sup> June from 1700. This meeting will be an opportunity for you to meet your child's new teacher and learn more about the induction process, including nursery and home visits. It will also be an opportunity for you to ask questions about us and get to meet other parents and children. Tea, coffee and biscuits will be available as well as a Creche for those who need to bring their children along. If you are unable to attend this meeting, please let us know and we will send out further information to you.

### **Induction Sessions**

The purpose of these sessions is for your child to get to know their new environment, teachers and friends and you can also meet new parents and find out about ways to help your child settle at school. Your child will have the opportunity to attend three induction sessions of those offered and you can sign up for the session you wish your child to attend at the new parents meeting. They will be held on the following dates:
