

A message from our school nurse...

In view of the increased cases of Flu this year, NHS England have taken the decision to extend the vaccination programme and make more vaccine available. Therefore there will be unexpected extended opportunities for your child to be vaccinated in community clinics; this is for those who have not already been vaccinated and are in the eligible cohort Year R, 1, 2, 3 or 4. This is regardless of whether you filled in a negative consent form in the first instance. If you would like to take up this opportunity please contact the immunisation team on: 0333 234 1125 to book into a community clinic. Please note that this will be offered on a first come/first serve basis until vaccine has run out, therefore early contact is advised.



Parking

Particularly at the end of the school day the roads get very busy and we all need to make sure that children are safe when leaving the school grounds.
