

The governing body does not get involved with the day to day running of the school which is the responsibility of the Headteacher or fundraising. We have five meetings a year plus termly committee meetings e.g. regarding curriculum or finance. Regular visits to the school will be necessary. Training is available. We currently have one parent governor vacancy.

### New Build Update.

As a member of the Governor Finance and Premises Sub Committee I thought parents would appreciate an update on the new build progress. I know Mrs Nock and all the staff at the school have been amazed as to how understanding and patient you have all been since the builders moved in. The temporary movement of the main entrance has been difficult but as always the problem has been dealt with in the usual efficient way and few problems have surfaced.

I am very pleased to report that the building works are on schedule. The new classroom, intervention room, offices and staff room that are being created in Phase 1 of the construction will make a huge difference to the operation of the school and most importantly to the effective education of your children. Topaz will be moving into the new classroom for the last term of the year, whilst work takes place in their classroom. Included in Phase 1 will be a much more welcoming, spacious and secure entrance area that will greatly enhance the look of the school. Phase 1 construction should be completed by May half term. In Phase 2 of the works, the studio will be the main focus of the builders, with the complete operation being due for completion by the second week of September. Mrs Nock, the staff and Governors thank you once again for your co-operation, patience and understanding and we all look forward to a world without the builders!
