PE Funding Policy

What is the Sports Premium?

The government is providing additional funding of £150 million per annum for three academic years to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see money going directly to primary school Head teachers.

The purpose of this grant is to fund improvements to the provision of PE and Sport, for the benefit of pupils aged 5-11 years old, in the 2013 - 2016 academic years so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles. This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools. Schools must spend the additional funding on improving their provision of PE and Sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

Provision in school

At Wilton and Barford we provide a range of high quality Physical Education and wide range of sport, however, our intention is that this funding will further enhance the current provision in school.

The Governors agree that the funding must be used so that:

- All children benefit regardless of sporting ability
- All children have the opportunity to compete in competitions at some level
- The most able children are given the opportunity to participate in high level competitions
- Staff have access to training opportunities and continued professional development
- The new funding should increase the range of sports available to children

The PE and Sports Premium Grant will be used in a number of ways to impact on pupil attainment, these include:

- To work with the South West Salisbury Cluster to develop sporting skills and compete in Inter-school competitions

Providing professional development time for teachers with specialist sports coaches;

- Employing a coach to provide weekly after school sport on the school site for KS1 and KS2
- To increase competitive opportunities within school
- Providing training for the lunchtime team to introduce playground games.
- Subsidising after school activities
- Transport to sporting events to allow as many children to participate as possible.
- Providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE/sport
- Running sport competitions, or increasing participation in the school games
- Purchase PE Resources
- Purchasing PE outdoor storage for new resource
- Talent identification and intensive coaching of those identified as talented in PE and Sport
- CPD staff training
- Accessing professional sports competitions

Reporting Outcomes

Updates on outcomes relating to our provision for PE and sport will be provided throughout the school year through the school newsletters and our website.

The impact of the funding will also be reported annually to parents and governors via the school website and termly *Governors Meetings*.

Financial Accountability

An updated financial spread sheet, showing spending to date, is available for Head teacher, Governors, DFE Officers, Ofsted and LA Officers at all times.
